The Language of Hooks and Chains

Christian writer A.W. Tozer spoke these profound and prophetic words, "We need a baptism of clear seeing. We desperately need seers who can see through the mist...Christian leaders with prophetic vision. Unless they come soon it will be too late for this generation. And if they do come, we will no doubt crucify a few of them in the name of our worldly orthodoxy." I see what is coming in this nation and I see what the church must become. I want you to see what happens to a nation that will not listen to God's voice any longer. I believe when a nation refuses to listen to God's voice, God will find another way to speak.

One day after millions celebrated the new year, 13 MILLION people thought they were going do a Monday Night Football Game and ended up at a prayer meeting. The Bills and Bengals game was interrupted when 24-year-old Damar Hamlin collapsed on the field in the first quarter after having a heart attack. His heart stopped and he died on the field. The NFL was 9 minutes into the game when tragedy struck. Then the miraculous happened live. While medics worked on Damar, America had a prayer meeting. 100 millionaires on that field knew then that their money couldn't fix Damar's heart but praying to God could. As they prayed and the medics worked, his heart started to beat again.

There were 3 things that I learned from that MONDAY NIGHT FOOTBALL game on January 2, 2023.

1. Money can't fix our nation, only prayer can

Some of the richest men in America on that field and in that stadium instinctively fell to their knees when they realized their resources can't revive a dead man. People pray when they are in distress.

2. When it comes to life and death, all the laws prohibiting prayer and God are out the door.

No one thought that night about what ESPN, the NFL, or the FCC would say about people praying to God. In fact, the next day on ESPN, while Damar was still in ICU, an ex-NFL player and commentator, Dan Orvlosky, stopped his commentary and prayed on live TV. He said, "God, we come to you and we believe You are God. We pray for healing for Damar, that You would heal him."

3. Finally, our nation can be brought to its knees in one single moment.

I believe revival in our nation will come that suddenly.

Multitudes prayed when people thought we were playing a game.

A physical heart attack seemed to awaken the spiritual hearts of people.

When a nation stops listening and stops praying, God will get our attention. God uses another language to get the attention of a nation that no longer responds to him. What language does God use? It's the language of hooks and chains.

We are now being warned about a new omicron variant, known as XBB.1.5, that is spreading like wildfire across the U.S. That same Monday night, Russian President Putin deployed a ship armed with the country's latest Zircon hypersonic missile into the Atlantic Ocean. That ship's hypersonic missiles are capable of penetrating any existing anti-missile defenses by flying nine times faster than the speed of sound at a range of more than 620 miles. Putin has emphasized that Zircon gives the Russian military a long-range conventional strike capability, allowing it to strike any enemy targets with precision.

We haven't even gone but a few days into 2023 and now new variants and threats are being reported.

It's amazing what distress, difficulty, and disaster will make people do. I believe it will make people turn to God. It's not God's preferred plan, but it is God's patience with us. This is the story of America and it's the story of Manasseh.

Manasseh is the story of a powerful Old Testament king that would not listen to God speak until God used a different language, the language of hooks and chains.

"The Lord spoke to Manasseh and his people, but they paid no attention. Therefore the Lord brought the commanders of the army of the king of Assyria against them, and they captured Manasseh with hooks, bound him with bronze chains, and took him to Babylon. When he was in distress, he entreated the Lord his God and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers. When he prayed to

Him, He was moved by his entreaty and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem to his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the Lord was God." 2 Chronicles 33:10–13 (NASB)

Did you see that Manasseh paid no attention to God until God used a different language, hooks, and chains? Manasseh ignored God until life became difficult and until Manasseh's power and resources couldn't fix his situation. That sounds very much like a Monday Night Football game on January 2nd.

When God chooses to speak this way to a stubborn people, C. S. Lewis reminds us of Divine Humility. That it is very gracious of God to be persistent with us, when we only turn to Him in desperation. Lewis says, "God is not proud. He will still have us even though we have shown that we prefer everything else to Him."

Sometimes no one ever really knows what lurks beneath the ground until things get a good shaking. A few years ago an April earthquake in the region of the Solomon Islands shook loose a World War II torpedo boat that had rested on the ocean floor for over 60 years. The entire boat hull was intact—explosives and all. Who knows what a good shaking can unearth?

And who knew that underneath such wretched disobedience of Manasseh that there would be a humble man?

What happened to Manasseh when God sent a shaking to Israel and He used hooks & chains to get him to his knees? In his distress, Manasseh humbled himself and prayed to God. II Chronicles 33:13 says that the shaking brought him to this revelation: "Then Manasseh knew that the Lord was God". It took hooks and chains to help Manasseh know that the Lord was God. The greatest thing that Manasseh received when he prayed, was not his throne back but his knowledge that the Lord was God. I believe a shaking is coming to our country.

Like the ocean earthquake, it will "unearth" things not seen for many years in America and multitudes will cry out to God. It's a shaking that will bring men to God once again. God is going to use the same language He did with Manasseh and it will have the same result. There is a distress coming to America. For decades, our country has not responded to God but a coming distress will make the nation pray again.

God is speaking today. The Bible constantly warns us not to treat the voice of God lightly. Three times in the book of Hebrews, there was this kind of warning. The book of Hebrews was written to a backsliding people. They were on the verge of going back to an old futile way of life without God. And this is what the author says repeatedly in Hebrews 3:8, 15; 4:7. Over and over again.

"Today if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts"

I didn't have a guide.


"Are you a bonefisherman?"

"I will be after today".

"Sir, have you ever been bonefishing before?"

"No".

"Sir, no one—no one—goes bonefishing without a guide", the manager cautioned me. You will never see them without a guide".



I tried bonefishing on my own without a guide. I was too proud to hire a guide and I didn't want to pay the price. But I couldn't find bonefish on my own. I spent months trying to find and catch a bonefish. I read magazine articles on how to catch a bonefish. I failed. But one day I swallowed my pride and hired a guide. He took me to the exact same place in Largo Sound where I had fished many times without seeing

them. Within a few minutes he pointed out a bonefish; I saw one for the first time. Before the day was over I hooked five bonefish. The guide made all the difference.

In preparing His disciples for the Holy Spirit to take His place, Jesus said that the Holy Spirit will "guide you into all truth" (John 16:13). Was the guide necessary? Absolutely. The natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God for they are "foolishness" to him (1 Cor.2:14). We need the Holy Spirit—the guide. The natural man thinks he can read the Bible and understand it since he can read architecture, science or psychology. Wrong. He thinks his great brain will help him understand the word of God. Wrong.
